Factory Street Studio Summer Performing Arts Camps

Factory Street Studio is offering a return of week-long, summer performing arts camps for students ages 7 – 12! Performing Arts Camps feature dance components offered in the morning and afternoon sessions alongside other activities supporting a variety of performing arts. Emphasis is placed on building self-esteem and supportive community through the act of creative expression.

FSS's Summer Performing Arts Camps are a great opportunity for young dancers to explore a variety of movement styles and develop their own creative voices. Final showings are held on the final Friday of each camp (typically during the last hour) for dance campers to share their creative works with family & friends!

Performing Arts Camp #1

June 12-16

A.M. theme: **Creepy Critters**

P.M. theme: **Float and Fly!**

Classes to include: African dance, Modern dance, yoga, choreography/composition and more!

Performing Arts Camp #2

July 10-14

A.M. theme: **We Got the Beat**

P.M. theme: **Appalachian Spring**

Classes to include: African dance, Modern dance, yoga, choreography/composition and more!

Performing Arts Camp #3

August 14-18

A.M. theme: **Carnival of the Animals**

P.M. theme: **Pits & Peaks!**

Classes to include: African dance, Modern dance, yoga, choreography/composition and more!

Cost

Schedule

Students will be divided into age appropriate groups (ages 7 – 9, 10 – 12) for morning and afternoon classes/activities. Students are encouraged to sign up for whole day camps but are welcome to sign up for half-day sessions as well. The daily schedule is approximately as follows:

9:00 – 9:15am	Check In/Welcome

10:30 – 10:45	Break
10:45 – 12:00	Activity #1 (groups A & B)
12:00 – 12:30	Lunch
12:30 – 1:00pm	Whole Group Activity
1:00 – 2:15	Dance Class #2 (groups A & B swap)
2:15 – 2:30	Break
2:30 – 3:45	Activity #2 (groups A & B swap)
3:45 – 4:00	Wrap Up
*4:00 – 5:00	Aftercare Activity (optional)

Studio Environment: Parents and guardians can expect that all faculty and staff will respect the well-being of each student, treat her/him fairly, and encourage their growth and self-esteem as dancers as stated in Factory Street’s mission statement. Should any concern or problem arise, do not hesitate to speak with faculty or the Artistic Director.

Lunch & Snacks: Students are to bring packed lunches for the lunch break at 12:00pm. There will be snacks available such as fresh fruit, local veggies, and tortilla chips; please let us know if your student has any allergies that we need to be aware of.

Supervision: Students will be accompanied by dance instructors and/or adult teacher assistants at all times. Our ratio of adults to students is 1:10. Students will remain on Factory Street Studio grounds the duration of the camp.

Attire: Dancers should wear dance clothes that allow for freedom of movement, but also allow instructors to assess alignment and proper form. We suggest a leotard and tights or leggings, bike shorts, or a close-fitting tank top or t-shirt. Absolutely no jeans, long skirts, or baggy clothing. Long hair should be worn away from the face in a ponytail or bun.

Summer Camp Student Drop-off and Pick-up: Students are to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to camp time. Students should be picked up promptly at the end of camp. Please call the office to let the instructor know your student will be late if you know you are running behind. Let us know if your student is sick and will not be attending class that day.

Tuition, Payments, and Refunds: *Tuition must be paid in full by June 2 for Camp #1, July 7 for Camp #2, and August 4 for Camp #3 to secure your students enrollment.* A non-refundable deposit of at least \$25 is due with the registration form. Refunds will not be given after these dates, except at the discretion of the director. Parents and guardians must contact the office in writing if their children will be dropping the camp.

Studio Etiquette: Just as teachers are expected to respect students, students are expected to respect the faculty and staff at FSS as well as the building and studios. As a matter of respect, we ask that students keep talking to a minimum during class and participate fully in the lesson. Students who consistently refuse to follow directions or respect their classmates may be asked to sit out of class. When using the studio, kitchen, lobby, and bathroom areas, students will be expected to clean up after themselves. No food or drink is permitted within the studios with the exception of water bottles. Gum is prohibited during class.

Enrollment is limited and is filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. A wait-list will be created after enrollment fills up.
