Choreography and Composition is the creative act of making dances. Through participation in the creative process, students of all ages are encouraged to explore their unique voice and develop skills that give form to personal expression. **Composition** class provides the structure for students to study compositional elements intensively and create pieces for performance in our Winter Concert and other outreach opportunities. **Junior/Senior Capstone** students study year-round toward the development of a piece that is unique to the student body/cohort. Students will develop a schedule and agenda that are then supported and nurtured by the instructor. **JR/SR Capstone students must be enrolled in a minimum of one technique class (modern, ballet, jazz, or tap)

Adult Classes – Adult classes do not require registration and have a \$10 per class “drop in” fee.

MULTI-CLASS DISCOUNTS - Highest price class is paid first; each additional class is 20% off (*does not apply Jr/Sr Capstone*). Classes that are \$185 become \$148. Classes that are \$155 become \$124 and classes that are \$140 become \$112. Tuition is capped at the sixth class registered for; no additional tuition will be charged for the 7th, 8th, 9th, (etc.) classes. Please note – capped classes are per dancer, not per family.
